Thanksgivings and information for audience and press.

- 1) I'm honored to be part of the Science Committee of the International Academy of Environmental Sciences, considered an important, international, Institutional and scientific reality which has strong connections with the city of Venice.
- 2) I'm also honored to be part of the international doctorate "*ECONOMICS AND TECHNIQUES FOR THE CONSERVATION OF THE ARCHITECTURAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL HERITAGE*" which, starting this year, had the important and significant patronage of the general Direction of the Council of Europe.

I would like to inform the press that the principles and contents of my research will be valued by me as part of my teaching.

In effect, I've been called to be part of the **teacher** and, especially, of the "**Permanent teaching staff**" of the University of Nova Gorica by the Director of the workshop "Environment, Health and Justice", Prof. Antonino Abrami and by the Director of the Doctorate, Prof. Sasha Dobricic.

I will also discuss about electromagnetic pollution and lessons will take place, as well as in Venice, also in Strasbourg and Paris.

On the international ad, I announce that an important scientific group is going to be created. This group will assist Prof. Antonino Abrami during his audition at the Council of Europe about the project "European Criminal Court" early next year.

I underline the importance of this audition because prof. Abrami and Freddy Grunert, founding member of IAES, with the help of a group of experts (lawyers, astrophysicists, biochemists, doctors etc.), which I'll be part of, will answer to questions that all the representatives of the countries of the Council of Europe and the audience connected via internet will ask.

It will be an extraordinary stage where, perhaps for the first time, will be an important discussion on the theme "Environment, Health and Justice".

What is more, at the conference of 29 March to Karlsruhe, organized by ZKM, Center for Art and Media, where prof. Abrami and Freddy Grunert, the presence of European institutional personalities will present this important initiative that has been already formalized by the Council of Europe.

Moreover, a great consent received by Prof. Antonino Abrami, during another hearing held at 14th of July 2010 at the European Parliament at Environment, Public Health and Food Safety Commission, gives us the prospect to the future successes of next important event.
